Kitchen/Bathroom Safety Checklist

- o Make sure circuits aren't overloaded to prevent potential electrical fires
- o Install safety latches or locks on cabinets
- o Purchase a fire extinguisher
- o Test smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors annually
- o Post an emergency-contact list on the fridge or in visible location
- o Purchase a first aid kit
- o Secure medications

- o Add nightlights with motion sensors

- o Create an emergency plan
- o Compile a home inventory to save time and stress from potential damage or break-ins

- o Change the door locks and install a deadbolt
- o Add a strike plate
- o Upgrade to smart locks
- o Boost security with a video doorbell
- o Reinforce sliding glass doors with window bars or dowels in the track
- o Add a door sensor or glass break sensor
